GENERAL RULES & REGULATION

ADMISSION POLICY

- 1. All admissions shall be on provisional basis and subject to confirmation of admission by the University.
- 2. The selection is made strictly on basis of merit and no separate entrance fee cha-rged. Regarding selection, the decision of IHRM Management is final. Any candidate found indulging in any sort of unfair means during the selection procedure is automatically disqualified.
- 3. All fees must be settled in full prior to the commencement of the course.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- **01.** Students should abide by the rules and regulations framed by the College from time to time.
- **02.** Attendance from the first day of every semester and on every college function is compulsory, failing which, the student is liable for punishment.
- **03.** No student would be eligible to appear for the University Examination, unless he / she has paid all his / her dues, completed his / her term work and must have registered minimum 75% attendance as per the University norms.
- **04.** Students should be punctual in attending all theory & practical classes. Break timings should be strictly adhered to.
- **05.** In case of leave on medical grounds, the student must inform the College immediately and submit the Medical Certificate later for office record.
- **06.** Internal marks will be granted to the student on the basis of his / her attendance, assignments, continuous evaluation and performance during the tutorials / internal examination.
- **07.** The College Authority is liable to punish any student on the basis of his/her continued absence, misconduct / misbehaviour or upsatisfactory performance.
- unsatisfactory performance. **08.** A student may be refused admission to practical and/or lectures, and may be marked absent if he/she has failed to bring the required journals, uniforms an equipment etc.
- **09.** Failed students will be permitted to appear for the examination as per the rules laid down by University.
- **10.** Students are expected to be well groomed and well behaved within the College premises.
- 11. Students are required to carry the College Identity Card on person within the College

- **12.** All students should be in prescribed uniform as per the Dress Code.
- **13.** Vehicles should be parked only in the demarcated parking lot, under lock & key. College will not be responsible for any loss or damage caused to their vehicles.
- **14.** Students must inculcate the habit of regularly reading the notices put up on the notice board.
- **15.** Smoking, consumption of alcohol, use of drugs and ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College Campus.
- **16.** Students should return all library books and clear all other dues before the end of each semester.
- **17.** Students shall not go to the press or any publicity media without prior permission of the College Authority.
- **18.** Any changes in the residential address and phone numbers of the student must be intimated to the College Office immediately.
- **19.** Vocational Training, Industrial Training and Out Door Catering (ODC) in hotels is compulsory and every student must complete the training satisfactorily, followed by the submission of Training Report.
- **20.** Students will not attend private Out Door Catering (ODC) during their tenure in the College.
- **21.** Parents/Guardians should to keep in touch with the College regularly with regard to the progress of their ward.
- 22. No student is allowed to use Mobile phones during lecturers and other academic activities in the College premises. Offenders will be punished & the mobile phone may be confiscated.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATION

STUDENT DISMISSAL POLICY

A student may be dismissed from the college for any of the following reasons:

- a) Giving false or misleading information on the app-lication form.
- b) Failure to achieve the minimum grade on two executive occasions.
- c) Disruptive or threatening behavior in the College and to wards fellow students or college staff.
- d) Cheating or helping others to cheat on exams, assigment ts or written papers.
- e) Failure to maintain the required level of attendan -ce. In case of absence. In case of absence for 15 consecutive days, the college must be informed with valid reasons and any failure to inform the college will be treated as discontinuance.
- f) Failure to pay the tuition fees.

ANTI-RAGGING

As per the directives from University to prevent ragging activities in colleges, our institute has in place an anti-ragging committee. This committee includes member representatives from teaching faculty, non-teaching faculty.

UNIFORMS FOR THE STUDENTS

All the students must wear the College uniform & be well groomed at all times.

RE-ADMISSION POLICY

Any student after discontinuance of the course wishes to rejoin the course later will have to adhere to fresh admission procedure. This re-admission procedure will strictly depend upon IHRM management and subject to availability of seats and cannot be claimed as a matter of right.

PAYMENT POLICY

Students can pay their Tuition Fee either by a direct bank transfer, Cash or Bank draft favoring "IHRM", payable at Kolkata. In case a student repeats a year /semester, he/she has to pay all fees applicable for the semester/year.

Fees must be paid by 10th of the month as per schedule. Students who fail to pay their fee within the stipulated time will be charged a late fine of Rs.25/- for each calendar day of default. The requisite fee along with the late fine should positively be paid within the same month.

Students who wishes to rejoin the same course after discontinuance caused due to default in payment of fees or due to any other reasons have to pay:

- a) Fees according to the revised fee structure, if in the new Batch.
- b) Late fine, as applicable

The re-admission fee apart from future installments in the revised fee structure applicable to the new batch.

REVISION AND INTERPRETATION OF RULES & POLICIES

The above rules and policies come into effect immediately on joining and equally apply on all existing students. IHRM holds the right to introduce, alter, amend or change any or all the rules from time to time, if found necessary. Interpretation of the rules will always bemade by the designated persons of IHRM and shall be final and binding on all concerned.
